# President's Report

The 2016 2017 season was the 5th season for our club since the merger of the East Malvern and Tooronga District cricket clubs. This season we decided to introduce a new nickname for our club given that we are now truly one club and it is time for EMTCC to forge its own identity; hence the adoption of the nickname Titans. I am pleased to say that the Titans has been enthusiastically adopted by one and all at the club.

On the field our club enjoyed another successful season in 2016 2017 with 4 sides making finals and a premiership being won by our MCA D side.

The clubs policy of promoting and developing its junior cricketers is still bearing great dividends. We again had a record number of junior players being selected in ISEC representative teams. A great endorsement of the clubs junior cricket program led by Brendan Smith and the dedicated group of parents who assist Brendan.

David Majtli joined the club this season as our Club Coach. David has made a tremendous impact at the club in his first year. His enthusiasm and passion for the game has rubbed off on the players and supporters. While we endured a frustrating season in terms of injuries and results, I am positive that next season we will start to see improvement throughout the club. We look forward to David's continued contribution to the club on and off the field.

I am pleased to report that finally the \$4 million redevelopment of the Dunlop Pavilion at DW Lucas Oval is due to commence. Construction will start by September this year and will take 12 to 15 months to complete. Whilst there will be some inconvenience for the club during the construction period the benefits of having an ultra-modern facility at the club will be enormous.

Apart from providing our players and members of the various sporting clubs first class facilities, it will lift the profile of each of the clubs and cement our place as the premier community sporting club in the eastern suburbs of Melbourne.

The Malvern Sports and Recreational Social Club (MSRSC) have made a commitment to contribute \$450K towards the cost of the project. The majority of these funds have been contributed from cash reserves held by the Malvern Junior Football Club. We have applied for grants from both Cricket Victoria and the AFL. Cricket Victoria have already committed \$40K towards the project for which we are truly grateful for. The MSRSC will need to raise approximately \$100K which will be done through fundraising and loans.

The clubs committee is focused on continuous improvement and future proofing our club. The Goals that the committee have set for the club are –

- To be the community cricket club of choice in the City of Stonnington for junior and senior cricketers and their families.
- Provide a vibrant and professional environment where our players can enjoy their cricket and develop their skills.
- Provide a pathway for our junior players to transition into senior cricket.
- Continue the promotion and development of female cricket within the club.

Specific initiatives that are in place include for the upcoming 2017/18 season are –

- The redevelopment of the Dunlop Pavilion.
- Continued implementation of structured and professional coaching programs across our junior and senior teams.
- More effective communication and engagement right throughout the club.
- Continued focus on Female cricket development.
- Attracting new players to the club.
- Build on the success of the Friday night Milo In2 and T20 Blast programme.
- Focus on events and fundraising across the club.
- Develop our relationships with our community partners and sponsors.
- Further engagement with our past players and life members.

I would like to personally thank the very dedicated and passionate group of people who support the club both on and after field. From our Committee members through to our junior team managers and coaches to the volunteers in the canteen on Friday nights, you all have made a significant contribution to the success of the 2016 2017 season.

- All the volunteers and parents who support the running of the Milo In2Cricket and T20 Blast program on Friday nights.

# Treasurers Report and Financial Statements

## Season 2016/17 : Andrew Hind

It the 2016/17 financial year the club changed its reporting methodology from cash to accrual accounting, as this better reflects underlying operational performance and separates large capital expenditure to the balance sheet. This year was a period of consolidation as we head to towards a period of significant capital expansion of the Dunlop Pavilion facility. An operating surplus of \$9,600 was an important achievement and was underpinned by strong performances in our subscription base, fundraising events and bar.

Subscription revenue from our senior and junior player streams continues to be the single biggest source of income, at 38% of the total revenue base, underscoring its importance for financial sustainability. However, significant gains were made this year in our fundraising revenue streams and even more notably our ancillary revenue from bar and canteen on Milo T20 and T20 Blast. The T20 Friday night program has been a success in many respects, not least that it has opened up the club and engaged with future players and parents, but it has also opened up a new social avenue for all members to enjoy with its attached revenue stream from the bar and canteen. This is a program that will only continue to grow.

The constant challenge for the club is to grow the revenue base so that it can continue to invest in its players and facilities, but also grow the revenue streams outside of player subscriptions to take the pressure off players and their parents. This is why the growth of revenue streams from sponsorship, fundraising and bar revenue are critically important to future growth and sustainability. Sponsorship revenue was slightly down on last year, which means it now presents as an opportunity to add to the growth of the other streams. The committee has already committed to a sponsorship growth strategy.

This year has demonstrated the importance in running an operating surplus in order to pay for capital expenditure. Of the \$9,600 operating surplus this year, \$3,000 was spent on capital equipment for the Waverley bar, with the balance already committed for a capital upgrade to the Waverley cricket training facilities. This is in addition to the capital contribution the club will have to make as our share of the Lucas redevelopment. The first of these contributions will be roughly \$43,000 early in the 2017/18 year. The club was incredibly fortunate to receive a \$40,000 grant from Cricket Australia and Cricket Victoria, which will cover the majority of this contribution. Further contributions the club will have to make at the completion of construction will have to come from fundraising efforts, both in partnership with the other Malvern Sports Club entities and on our own.

The next few years present many opportunities for the club, culminating in taking residence in the redeveloped Lucas facility. It is now important that e double down on our efforts to keep growing the club so that we can enjoy those opportunities more than ever.

Hitting more balls at training (Having a net session is not enough to improve)

Playing & having a plan against spin bowling (Work in progress)

##### **Bowling**

Executing under pressure in matches (More bowling/fitness at training)

We need to be more patient with our plans (Build pressure which will lead to wickets) rather than try to take a wicket with every ball we bowl (Provides opportunities for batsman to score leading to boundary balls)

Fielding

Anticipating where the ball will go in the field (A general want & hunger to field the ball)

Practice by repetition at training (You can never do enough fielding).

## **1<sup>ST</sup> ELEVEN REPORT:**      **DAVID MAJTLIS**

It was a frustrating season as the close games didn't go our way, but sometimes you make your own luck. We were also hampered by player unavailability which prevented the fielding of a consistent team week by week.

Overall our batting was reasonable but we struggled to build meaningful partnerships. Batsmen need to put a higher value on their wickets and do the basics for longer. We also need to improve our batting RPO by rotating the strike better and doing more work at training (hitting more balls).

We had good plans as a fielding unit but didn't execute as we would have wished often enough. Our fielding needs a lot of work. More emphasis will be put on this next season. It is a priority to recruit a strike bowler who is capable of knocking batsmen over. All our bowlers would benefit from this.

It was particularly pleasing to see the younger players given a go in the firsts make a good go of it at that level in the second half of the season. This will bear fruit from next season on.

I believe that the First XI group has the talent to match it with any other side in the competition. Players need to commit more strongly next season to training and regular match day availability to achieve the consistency the other seasoned teams demonstrate

The 2nd XI is the most important team in any cricket club as it should teach the younger players good habits and routines for development and growth.

We are very lucky as a club to have so many old heads who are still playing in this side and developing our coming younger players. Next year having an constant captain is a priority.
